PRAYER REQUEST FOR THE ALABAMA SUPREME COURT

The case, *McInnish v. Chapman*, is a case, one among several, that questions Mr. Obama's legitimacy to serve as our president. It is, however, unique in its legal approach.

We are now on appeal before the Alabama Supreme Court. In an earlier case, Associate Justice Tom Parker commented that:

McInnish has attached certain documentation to his mandamus petition, which, if presented to the appropriate forum as part of a proper evidentiary presentation, would raise serious questions about both the "short form" and the "long form" birth certificates of President Barack Hussein Obama that have been made public.

Should we succeed, our success could prove a precedent for other states to follow, resulting in something significant happening on our long fight for the truth.

Do not communicate directly or indirectly with the justices regarding this case, since that would be highly unethical and unprofessional. Do communicate about this legal matter with the Creator who spoke the universe into existence. We only want His divine will to be done. May His kingdom come on earth as it is in heaven.
